

Wolverhampton Camera Fair – Booking Terms & Conditions

1. Stallholders are advised that they are solely responsible for their goods. Neither the Organisers, nor Dunstall Park Limited shall be held responsible for any loss or damage to stallholders' property whilst on the premises, however caused.
2. Stallholders agree to indemnify and hold harmless both the Organisers and Dunstall Park Limited against any losses, claims, demands, actions, proceedings, damages, costs or expenses as a result of the death of or injury to any person arising out of the Wolverhampton Camera Fair.
3. Neither the Organisers, nor Dunstall Park Limited will be held responsible for any transaction between stallholders, or between stallholders and members of the public. It is the sole responsibility of the stallholders to ensure that all transactions comply with such legislation as may be applicable and that all relevant taxes and duties have been paid.
4. Neither the Organisers, nor Dunstall Park Limited will be held responsible for any claims for loss, damage, death, injury, or consequential damage arising from any of the equipment offered for sale at the fair. It is the stallholders' responsibility to ensure that any goods offered for sale are safe and comply with the relevant legislation.
5. Neither the Organisers, nor Dunstall Park Limited will be held responsible for any costs, claims demands or expenses arising from the cancellation, late opening or reduced hours of the fair arising from circumstances beyond their control.
6. Stallholders must comply with Health & Safety and Fire Regulations. Fire Exits must under no circumstances be blocked and aisles must be kept free from obstruction. Stallholders must comply with reasonable requests from the Organisers or representatives of Dunstall Park Limited. This is a No Smoking venue.
7. It is the stallholders' responsibility to ensure that their table is staffed at all times. Stallholders may only use tables supplied by the Organisers and may not extend their allocated area without the Organisers' express permission. Each stallholder is allowed 1 helper per table purchased.
8. Stallholders' vehicles must be cleared promptly from the Parade Ring area after unloading.
9. Stallholders shall conduct themselves in an honest and courteous manner at all times.
10. Stallholders shall agree and sign these terms before they are permitted to operate at the fair.
